FISCAL YEAR 2019

To process your Clause 41C application, please submit the following information to us:

1. Birth Certificate (only needed the first year)
 2. Proof of Residence
 3. Proof of Income for Year Ending December 31, 2017.
 - a. Social Security Benefit Statement for 2017
 - b. Federal Income Tax Form 1040 (if filed) for 2017
 - c. Pensions and Retirement Year End Statements from 2017
 - d. Wages or Salaries (W-2) from 2017
 - e. All Interest & Dividend Statements- 1099-int 1099-div forms for 2017
If necessary, a letter from your bank stating any interest, even if zero, earned during calendar year 2017
 - f. Any and all other Income Earned in 2017
 4. Proof of all assets on **July 1, 2018**
 - a. Bank Books
 - b. Bank Statements that include the 7/1/18 date
 - c. Stocks & Bonds Statements with the 7/1/18 date
 - d. Other Real Estate
 - e. CD's & Certificates, etc.
- You may submit applications for Exemption to the Assessor's Office beginning July 1st.
 - The deadline for filing an exemption is three (3) months after the actual tax bill is issued in December 2018.
