Budget preparations continue during this holiday season. The Comprehensive Financial Advisory Committee (CFAC) has prepared a Financial Overview Report for the current fiscal year, which began on July 1, 2018. Using the information from hundreds of pages of complex budget information, CFAC prepared a concise, easy to read Financial Overview Report. In this well-organized brochure, one will find information on our government structure, property taxes, the fire and water districts, general fund resources and general fund budget, the capital budget, enterprise funds, public education budget, and other statistics. We thank CFAC for the work that went into preparing this booklet. A copy of the <u>5 Year</u> <u>Financial Forecast</u> is now available on the Town's website for public viewing. This report is submitted annually to town council and the public. The purpose of this financial forecast is to identify factors that may impact the financial condition of the Town such as, revenue and expenditure trends and any long- or short-term actions that may be taken into account.

We have noticed an increase in good will gestures throughout the community and especially here at Town Hall. Our employees continue to give generously as do so many of you.

The election is over and 66% of Barnstable voters turned out to cast their ballots in November. We have seen many of you taking advantage of early voting this year. The consensus was "it was great!" Many voters said they were happy to early vote and have it over.

My poll workers and the DPW workers have performed admirably through the early voting and through the Election with smiles on their faces and many extra hours of work. A colossal thank you to all of the poll workers and wardens who made the election possible for more than 22,000 people; thanks also goes to the DPW workers, Police Officers, facility and maintenance staff at the churches, schools and other locations. Additionally, the folks that volunteered their time to assist us with the early voting, many thanks to former Town Clerk Linda Hutchenrider, Community Services Director Lynne Poyant, Town Councilors Jessica Rapp Grassetti and Britt Beedenbender, and Town Attorney Ruth Weil, you made a tremendous difference. My last big thank you goes to my staff for not only working long hours, but working under difficult situations and doing a wonderful job.

The next large project that we are working on is to prepare for the annual census. This will be going out, hopefully, by the first week in January. The census is required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; and the Federal Motor Voter Law requires us to do an annual voter confirmation. Consequently, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts has directed clerks to utilize the same form to get both jobs done. With the census/voter confirmation form we are just verifying that you are still at that address. If there are any changes that need to be made to the form; or additions or deletions to your family; write the changes on the form and return it to us. Our goal is to keep all voters active!

I hope you all enjoy the festivities that December can bring. With the varied celebrations of Kwanzaa, Hanukkah and Christmas, it truly is a season to rejoice.

May your holidays be filled with joy, laughter, family and friends.

A Note from the Town Collector

We hope you all had a wonderful Thanksgiving! We are in the process of working on the Actual Real Estate and Personal Property tax bills to be issued by December 31, 2018. As usual, the billing will be a three part bill with a coupon for February, a coupon for May and a taxpayer receipt. The schedule is:

Actual Tax Bills will be mailed by December 31, 2018 Third Quarter due February 1, 2019 Fourth Quarter due May 1, 2019

If you use a checking/savings account, the charge is 40 cents and if you use a debit/credit card, the fee is a percentage based fee of 2.95% of the amount being paid. Superíntendent's Corner



BARNSTABLE PUBLIC SCHOOLS CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

As we near the mid-point of Fiscal Year 2019, we continue our construction and planning activities on existing and upcoming Capital Improvement Projects (CIPs). The following is an overview of our current and upcoming projects:

Barnstable Community Horace Mann Charter Public School Roof and Façade

Renovations – all work has been completed on this project. Renovations to the facility included full replacement of both the flat and sloped roofs, replacement of all wood trim (soffits, rakes, and eaves with composite materials), new gutters/downspouts, a total rebuild of the cupola using custom composite millwork and copper and

replacement of the rear entrance porticos. Additionally, improvements were made for the ease of accessibility for parking, entry and rest rooms.

Barnstable High School 21st Learning Center Project – the Barnstable High School Library has undergone a major transformation including a state of the art HVAC system, new window walls with programmable auto tinting features which account for changes in outside ambient light to control solar gain during the heating and cooling seasons. The interior space has been upgraded to include new acoustical flooring and wall panels, lighting, furniture and improved audio/visual features. The grand opening is scheduled for after the Holiday Break.



Barnstable High School Cafeteria Storefront – renovation work on the BHS cafeteria main façade has been completed with replacement of the storefront glass, panels and doors. The renovation also included the replacement of 9 rectangular fixed windows.

Districtwide Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP) Phone System – the Barnstable High School Phone and PA system were replaced over summer break and were operational for the start of the school year. We are currently planning conversion at the Barnstable United

Elementary School over winter break followed by Barnstable Intermediate during spring/summer. The new VOIP system will eventually connect all of our district's facilities via our fiber network allowing easy 4 digit dialing between any location.

Barnstable High School Athletic Fields Upgrades – we have finalized schematic design and have completed both survey and geo tech activities. Work will now focus on final design development, creation of construction documents, permitting and bidding and a spring construction start.

Barnstable High School HVAC Upgrades – we are currently working with engineering to develop plans and specifications to replace HVAC Roof Top Units 4, 5 & 6. These units provide service to the entire high school 1400's wing excluding the field house and gym. This work is scheduled to commence in 2019/2020.

NEW FLIGHTS FROM BARNSTABLE TO NEW YORK CITY & BEYOND!

As a regional transportation hub the Barnstable Municipal Airport provides the community with an array of multi-modal transportation options from flights to rental cars and bus service all with convenient on-site parking. New this year, community members and visitors can take advantage of off-season flights to JFK Airport in New York from Barnstable, happening daily, right now until Spring!

With jetBlue having concluded seasonal service to New York for the year,

Cape Air recognized the need and has started daily service. Flights depart each day at 9:00AM from Barnstable and fly to JFK Airport in New York with a brief stop on the way on Nantucket. Later in the day a return flight from JFK, through Nantucket returns to Barnstable.

This new service provides exceptional connectivity from Barnstable to New York City! Travelers can also fly from Barnstable through JFK Airport to destinations all over the world! With this air service a passenger could skip the commute off Cape, fly from Barnstable to New York and connect to a variety of destinations from Florida to California and beyond!

In addition, Cape Air continues to offer flights to Nantucket and Boston and Rectrix Shuttle provides flights to Nantucket on a daily basis from Barnstable. jetBlue seasonal service provides direct flights from Barnstable to New York during the summer each year. 
